

# CITY OF HOLLISTER CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP

Saturday April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018

*Please read through this information carefully to ensure you meet the guidelines of this program!*

The City -wide clean-up is Saturday 2018 and is only for Residents inside the City of Hollister paying for Trash Services through the City of Hollister. This program is being offered with the intent of providing the opportunity to clean out their garage, basement or closets, and get rid of old worn out items and junk. Not intended for residents outside the city or remodels.

## **CURBSIDE PICK-UP**

- \* Citizens must have their acceptable items at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. the morning of Saturday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, for pick-up and are encouraged to put items out the night before as we will be running multiple trucks.
- \* Any non-acceptable items that are included will be left at the curb for disposal by the resident.
- \* Crews cannot access personal property including trailers or assist in moving items to the curb.
- \* Clean-up **will not** take place at businesses, apartment buildings or at vacant homes
- \* **NO CONSTRUCTION/LARGE REMODEL PROJECT**

## **ACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

- Furniture – Indoor/Outdoor\*
- Hand and Power Tools
- Beds/Mattresses
- No more than two (2) large furniture items\* - Sofa, Chair, table,
- Toys/ Basketball Goals ( Must be broken down to 5' ft. lengths)
- Carpeting/Padding (Must be cut in 4' or smaller sections)
- Microwaves
- Televisions/Monitors
- Grills - NO Propane Tanks
- Small Push Mowers (Must be drained of all fuel and oil)
- Weed Eaters (Must be drained of all fuel and oil)
- \*\* Appliances

\*\* Appliances include Washer, Dryer, Stove, Hot Water Heater- \*\*Refrigerators/Freezers must have Freon removed and properly tagged by a certified specialist. If not properly tagged, the item will not be picked up.

## **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED**

- Tires
- NO Construction or Large Remodeling
- Brush/Limbs/Yard Waste
- Items over 5' ft. Length
- Rocks, bricks, concrete
- Bulk Liquids
- Propane Tanks
- Fluorescent/CFL/HID Bulbs
- Batteries
- Appliances with Freon - not properly tagged
- Medical Items (Needles)
- No Vehicle Parts (Motors, Doors, Hoods, etc.)
- Hazardous Waste (including paint, oil, aerosol cans, fertilizers, etc.)
- No Riding Mowers or Boats
