Renew by July 31 to avoid late fees!!

All businesses are required to visibly display a Business License sticker for the year 2017.

Fire inspections are required for all businesses that are open to the public. Business License fees are based on the number of employees. Additional fees are added for liquor sales and inspection fees.

Need a Building Permit??

When planning to remodel or add-on to a current structure or construct or place a new building on your lot, contact the Planning and Building Department prior to beginning work. In addition to permits, you may need confirmation that set-backs are met and inspections are scheduled. This may save time and costs from mistakes or code violations. Contact Planning and Building prior to the start of any construction project within the City limits.
