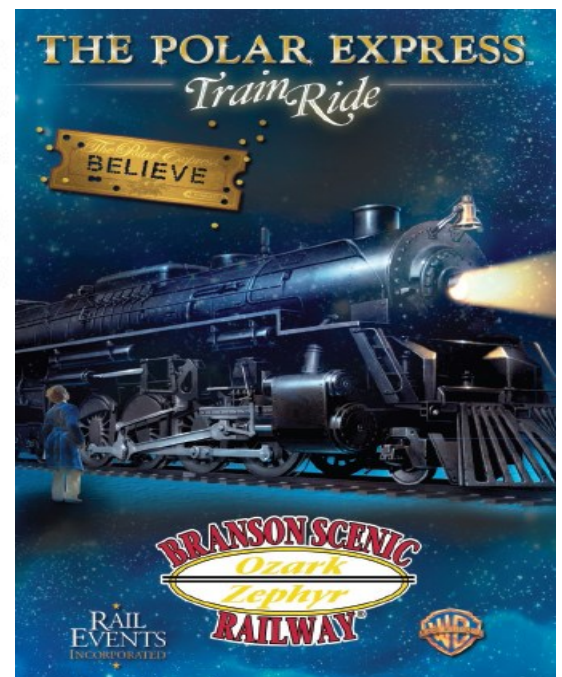

\$3.00. After January 31st a \$25.00 penalty is assessed.
