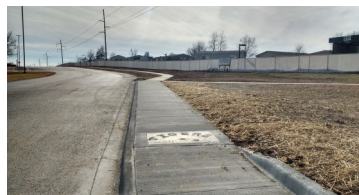

Sidewalk Completed Along BB Highway

Students are now able to walk safely along BB Highway to-and-from school on the recently completed sidewalk. Landscaping will finish the project once weather permits. Hollister Public Works employees worked along-side AT Urban Development to complete the sidewalk. A federal grant provided for 80% of the funding, while the City of Hollister and Hollister R-V School District split the remaining 20%.



Night Safety Tips

Observing some simple rules will increase your safety while walking after dark and improve your visibility to motorists.

- ◆ Wear reflective gear. This will especially increase your visibility to motorists.
- ◆ Use a flashlight or headlamp to light your way.
- ◆ Walk on sidewalks and off-road paths, and walk facing traffic.
- ◆ Use extra caution when crossing streets to ensure motorists see you. Use crosswalks when available.
- ◆ Use routes traveled by other walkers: safety in numbers.
- ◆ Watch for tripping hazards and uneven ground.
- ◆ Be alert. Avoid using headphones, cellphones or other devices while walking. Be aware of your surroundings and the people in your area.

Keep all cul-de-sacs clear for emergency vehicles.

East Side of Town:

1. BB Hwy from Business 65 to East City Limits
2. Knox Avenue from BB Hwy to Princeton Avenue
3. Evergreen Street from Business 65 to White River Mountain Blvd.
4. Presbyterian Street from Business 65 to Knox Avenue
5. Brianna Drive from BB Hwy to Hollister Elementary School
6. White River Mountain Blvd. from BB Hwy to Rock Spring Court
7. Hidden Valley Road
8. Railroad Avenue from Business 65 to West Avenue

West Side of Town:

1. Maple Street South of Business 65
2. Maple Street North of Business 65
3. Esplanade from Business 65 to and including Taneycomo Hill Drive
4. First Street from Business 65 to Esplanade
5. 2nd Street from Esplanade to Elm
6. Birch Street from Business 65 to South Maple
8. Industrial Park Drive from Birch Street to Dead End
9. Blue Sky Lane from Business 65 to Airport
10. Historic Highway 165 from Business 65 to West City Limits
