Hollister Schools Partners with Taney County Health Department on Farm to School Grant



The Taney County Health Department was one of 65 recipients of the USDA Food and Nutrition's Farm to School Grant that provides support and technical assistance to develop a sustainable farm to table community. Hollister Schools, along with Springfield Catholic, have two years to work with area producers to teach students about food, farming and healthy choices when eating. The goal of the Farm to School program is to serve no less than 20 percent of local products in school lunches and to have them delivered within 48 hours of harvest. The grant also helps to make the creation of school gardens and greenhouses possible, along with the implementation of nutrition education and garden-based curriculum in the schools. The program is coordinated through the University of Missouri Extension. The Taney County Health Department's Farm to School program is currently looking for local growers. 6. White River Mountain Blvd. from BB Hwy to Rock Spring Court
7. Hidden Valley Road

West Side of Town:

1. Maple Street South of Business 65
2. Maple Street North of Business 65
3. Esplanade from Business 65 to and including Taneycomo Hill Drive
4. First Street from Business 65 to Esplanade
5. 2nd Street from Esplanade to Elm
6. Birch Street from Business 65 to South Maple
7. Industrial Park Drive from Birch Street to Dead End
8. Blue Sky Lane from Business 65 to Airport
9. Historic Highway 165 from Business 65 to West City Limits
10. Railroad Avenue from Business 65 to West Avenue
11. Shockley from West Avenue to Dead End

Please remember to bring a copy of your pet's current rabies vaccination certificate from your veterinarian. Each pet license is \$3.00. After January 31st a \$25.00 penalty is assessed.
